

**Minimum Core Elements of Required  
Course Work or Training in  
Infection Prevention and Control**

**Element I**

The responsibility to adhere to scientifically accepted principles and practices of infection prevention and control and to monitor the performance of those for whom the professional is responsible.

**Element II**

Modes and mechanisms of transmission of pathogenic organisms in the healthcare setting and strategies for prevention and control.

**Element III**

Use of engineering and work practice controls to reduce the opportunity for patient and healthcare worker contact with potentially infectious material for bloodborne pathogens.

**Element IV**

Selection and use of barriers and/or personal protective equipment for preventing patient and healthcare worker contact with potentially infectious material.

**Element V**

Creation and maintenance of a safe environment for patient care through application of infection prevention and control principles and practices for cleaning, disinfection, and sterilization.

**Element VI**

Prevention and management of infectious or communicable diseases in healthcare workers. Safe Injection Practices

**Element VII**

Prevention, early recognition, identification, diagnosis, and management of SEPSIS
