

Guide For Visiting Your Family During A Pandemic

Nassau University Medical Center is committed to helping you and loved ones connect in the safest way possible. Under New York State Department of Health NUMC has limited visitors.



Visiting hours are 2pm-6pm, 7 days a week, only one visitor at the bedside at a time.



Visitors who fail to agree to wear personal protective equipment will be asked to leave.



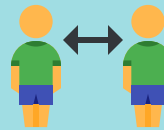
Visitors must provide valid ID and undergo symptom screening including temperature check and travel questions upon entry to the hospital.



Visitors on the 14 day self quarantine list imposed by New York State traveling from a state experiencing a spike in COVID-19 should not visit.



Upon arrival, visitors will be asked to use hand sanitizer and wear a face mask. This mask must be worn at all times.



Avoid contact (no handshaking) and keep at least **6-feet** from others at all time.



All visitors must perform proper hand hygiene and wear personal protective equipment (PPE) as identified by the nursing team.
