Examples of eligible expenses are deductibles, co-pays, prescription eyeglasses, vision exams, dental expenses and many others. A Dependent Care Flexible Spending Account (FSA) is designed to reimburse for expenses incurred to care for your eligible dependents. Examples of eligible expenses are daycare, after school care and elder care.
